

Haryana

1. As on 30.9.2015, the total installed capacity (including allocated share in joint and central sector utilities) of Haryana was 8510.81 MW. In the total installed capacity of the Haryana, the share of State Sector was 3813.81 MW whereas share of Central Sector was 2456.61 MW and the share of Private Sector was 2240.39 MW.
2. The energy deficit in Haryana was 69 MU (0.1%) during (2015-16) which was lower than national average (2.1 %) during same period.
3. The average AT&C losses of Haryana was 27.55% during 2014-15. However, Haryana has projected to reduce the AT&C losses at 15% level by 2021-22. Haryana has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) under the Scheme UDAY – “Ujwal DISCOM Assurance Yojana”. The Scheme – UDAY has been launched to improve financial and operational efficiencies of power distribution companies (DISCOMs).
4. Haryana has also signed Power for All scheme of Ministry of Power for 24x7 quality & reliable power supply to the consumers.
5. As per 2011 census, there were 6642 villages in Haryana. All villages are electrified.
6. Haryana has 29.66 lakhs rural households. Out of 29.66 lakhs rural household, 26.81 (90.3%) lakhs households has been electrified till date. The State Government should work proactively to electrify all rural households in the State.
7. R-APDRP scheme has been subsumed in Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS) in November 2014. Under this scheme, 36 towns are covered under Part-A of R-APDRP and 70% funds have been released whereas 1 towns are covered under Part-B of R-APDRP and 15% funds have been released as on date. The work progress is slow. The State Government should accelerate the work progress of R-APDRP for financial health of power sector.
8. Meanwhile, 47 towns are covered under Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS) in Himachal Pradesh. However, Government of India has approved Rs. 388.65 crore for 47 towns. Out of which Rs. 233.17 crore is approved as grant for these towns whereas Rs. 23.31crore grant released till now.
